BRITISH NATIONAL FORMULARY 1966

Enclosed are a copy of the British National Formulary 1966 and the New Zealand Supplement to the Formulary.

There is now only one edition of the Formulary for use by both doctors and pharmacists.


It should be borne in mind that not all preparations listed in the British National Formulary 1966 are included in the Drug Tariff. Some of the additions to the Formulary may be added to the Drug Tariff from 1 December 1966, and some titles not retained in the new edition of the Formulary will then be excluded.

Amendments to the composition of formulae are listed on page 275 of the Formulary.


Please note that the New Zealand Supplement to the British National Formulary 1966 bases mixtures for adults on a *10 ml dose volume*.

To avoid confusion, the British National Formulary 1966 and its New Zealand Supplement should not be used before 1 September 1966.
